Recording Notes and Track List:

This music on this disc was recorded live during liturgies and concerts between 2013 and 2015 – not within sterile confines of a recording studio, but rather as part of the active worship life of an Episcopal parish. As such, you will occasionally hear sounds from inside and outside the church, just as you would experience on any given Sunday morning.

Most tracks on this disc were recorded at St. Thomas Episcopal Church in Battle Creek, MI. Four tracks were recorded at the Parish Church of St. Luke, Evanston, IL, during a choir tour. One was recorded at All Saints Chapel of the University of the South in Sewanee, TN. These recordings are laid out in a manner intended to take the listener through the liturgical year – beginning with Advent and continuing through the many seasons of faith.
